Recreational Activities

There are playgrounds and play areas for ball games on site.
Children must be accompanied by an adult (over 18) if they leave the Park.

Cycles, scooters and Skateboards

Skateboards are not allowed on this site.
For safety reasons, cycles and scooters are not allowed on the paved area around the toilet blocks. Cycles must be ridden with care and with lights after dark.
Cycles may not be ridden around the farm.

Motorised mobility

Scooters are allowed on site but children's motorised scooters etc. are not. Please observe the signs when cycling on site.

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the Park, and clean up after them.
Dogs can be walked on a lead off-site on the many dog walks

around the farm & on the public footpath adjoining the site.
